Abbreviations:
AB = Abbey outfall (yellow buoy)
BB = Bodlondeb buoy (green buoy on the seaward side of Bodlondeb point
CC = Conwy cob buoy (yellow buoy off the Cob)
ChCo = 'Pass to seaward of the Perch and then between all paired channel buoys leaving all other channel marks on the correct side according to direction of travel (ie into or out of the estuary)'.
CM = Club mark
D = Deganwy buoy
FB = Ten Foot Bank Buoy
FW = Conwy Fairway Buoy
FL2 = Finish line between C2 and C1. Yachts must cross the finish line within 5 boat lengths of C2
FLc = Finishing Line is a line projected from the two transit poles on the shore at the Club Tower.
FLf = Fairway finish line – a line between the Fairway Buoy and C2. Yachts must cross the finish line within 5 boat lengths of C2
FLs-(Buoy) = Finish Line between the Guard Boat (Sior) and a designated mark, e.g. FLs-12 is a finish line between the blue flag on Sior and channel buoy C12.
ND = North Deep marks (Green) numbered from seaward.

T = Tunnel mark (yellow buoy off the seaward end of the tunnel bund Deganwy side of the river)

OLO = Orme long outfall (yellow buoy)

PI = Puffin Island

SL = Starting Line is a line projected from the two transit poles on the shore at the Club Tower. Channel buoy C16 is the outer distance mark but may not be on the start line.

SLs-(Buoy) = Start line between the Guard Boat (Sior) and a mark, e.g. **SLs-14** is a start line between the Orange flag on Sior and channel buoy C14.
